

Munzbach – January 1st 2019 – Shurgard, one of the leading self-storage companies, wishes to react to the fire at its store at Croydon Purley Way, south of London. The building caught fire around 7:45 PM on December 31st 2018. No casualties have been reported by the London Fire Brigade. The entire building has been destroyed. Damage to the surrounding area seems to be limited, but for safety reasons traffic has been blocked for the time being.

Shurgard representatives at the scene are working in close collaboration with the London Fire Brigade and the local police department to provide them with all necessary information on the store.

The care for its customers of the 1198 rented units at the Croydon Purley Way store is the first priority for Shurgard. Shurgard will undertake every effort to support all customers for which the event means a loss of their stored goods. As a first measure a dedicated Shurgard team will be contacting every customer of the store within the next 48 hours to help them and support them with their claim procedures.

Shurgard is also currently collaborating with the London Fire Brigade and the local police department, as well as its insurance company, in order to identify the source and cause of the fire.

The company will provide updates as information becomes available.
